- Case Management
- Advocacy for child at school, home and medical appointments where needed and/or requested.
- Plan of Action (reviews and assessments every 3 months)
- I am A Kind Man Youth Initiative program for child/youth Ages 7-15 years old. (Healthy equal relationships)
- Referrals to community programs
- 1:1 Peer counselling (coping and anger management strategies) in school and home.
- Cultural Teachings, Children's sweats, Teaching circles, Medicine Walks, Tee-Pee circles, F/C Land Visits

- Case Management
- Referrals for parents within the Friendship Centre and other appropriate community agencies.
- Weekly Parent Support Group Tuesday's 12 - 2pm.
