

The vision of the Apatisiwin program is that Indigenous people gain education, experience, and skills to achieve and maintain meaningful employment.

Apatisiwin offers several employment and training services with 11 client interventions. Interventions are defined as an action plan activity, within a specific timeframe, developed by the client and Employment Coordinator intended to assist a client to improve employability in order to prepare for, obtain and/or maintain employment.

### **PROGRAM GOAL:**

To provide opportunities for Urban Aboriginal people who reside in Ontario to improve their lives through culturally relevant services delivered through an employment-focused, demand-driven program model.
